



RULES & REGISTRATION

1. The contest is open to children (8-17) and adults 18 years or older
2. Amateur bakers only. No professional bakers can enter this competition. (A professional is defined as someone who works for a bakery, works for or owns a catering company, or sells pies).
3. Crusts and filling must be made from scratch. No store brought crust, dough, or canned fillings may be used. Each pie must contain at least a bottom crust. Bake pies in a disposable pie tin or plate. **Pies & pie tins will not be returned after judging.**
4. Pie must be prepared & baked by the individual submitting the pie entry for judging.
5. Please do not write your name on the pie tin. Your entry will be assigned a number at registration to allow for anonymity during judging.
6. Pies must be dropped off before 10:00 AM April 1st at the Atoka BBQ Fest judging tent.
7. Judging is done by Mayor Walker & Other Community Leaders. There will only be one prize given at that is for Mayor's Choice
8. **NO PIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ATER 10:00 AM.**

Judging

1. Each pie will be judged on the following criteria:
 - Overall appearance: crust and filling color, creative detailing, even distribution of filling, etc.
 - Overall flavor: fresh taste, texture, doneness, consistency, etc.
 - Originality: creativity in appearance and flavor
2. The decision of the judges is final. Judges will not know participants names.
3. The public is invited to watch the judging.
4. The winners will be announced at the awards ceremony scheduled for 5:30 PM.
