

FAQs

How do I sign up?

The easiest method of registration is through our www.townofatoka.com/letsplay website. Registration is also available over the phone by calling (901)837-5300 or in person at Town Hall Monday – Friday 8:00am – 5:00pm. We accept cash, check, Visa, MasterCard, or Discover.

How does class enrollment work?

Each class is 1 hour for 6 weeks. When you enroll you child(ren), (s)he is enrolled for the entire course. Payment is due upon registration. Supplies are NOT part of the enrollment fee. You can register for supplies as well through our website OR you can bring them from home.

What fees are involved for classes?

A one time fee is of \$60-75 is due upon enrollment, depending on which class is selected. If you choose to add the supply kit, there will be an additional fee. There will be NO additional supplies for you student to use, so please make sure your student has supplies before the first class! Students without supplies will not be able to participate, which will be a bummer for everyone!

What is STEAM or STEM Art?

STEM stands for Science Technology Engineering and Math. We are adding ART! In these classes, we will use unique methods to make some wickedly awesome art.

Do you offer discounts for siblings?

Due to the limited space, siblings are not eligible for a discount at this time.

Why is the online system giving an error message on my child's age?

Sometimes, our system has a glitch. If you are attempting to register your child, it can sometimes be because your time of registration and their birthday cut off do not align. No

Where can I buy supplies?

*Please note: registration for supply kits closes on the Friday before the first class. We use Amazon Prime, so we need to allow time for delivery.

My child isn't artistic; can they still take the course?

What should my child wear to class?

Although, most of our supplies are washable, some stains may still be hard to remove. We recommend wearing clothes you don't mind getting a little messy!

Can parents stay during the class?

We want to encourage artistic independence from our students. We encourage parents to use art class as "me time"! However, there are chairs in the foyer if you wish to stay in the building. We do ask that you make sure the contact information on your registration profile is correct, in the event we do need to call someone.

What happens if the class is full?

We are offering the classes one night a week. If they fill up, we will look into adding an additional class section to accommodate for more students.

Are there prerequisites for these classes?

There are no prerequisites! We will adapt our classes to the skill level of the students to make it engaging for everyone.
